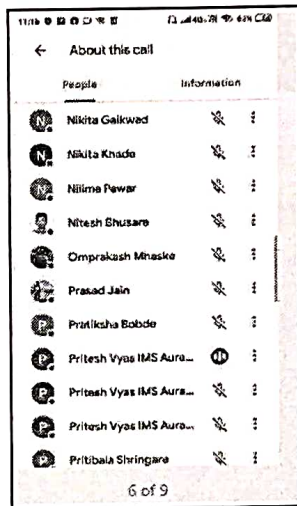
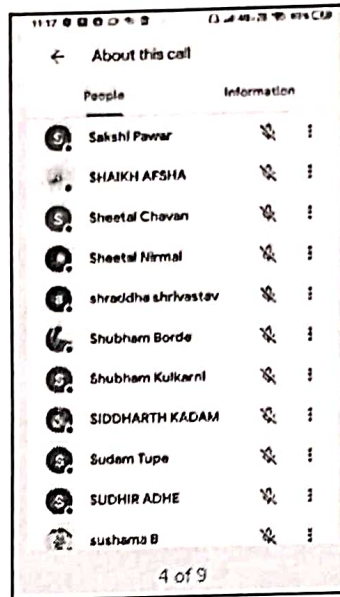
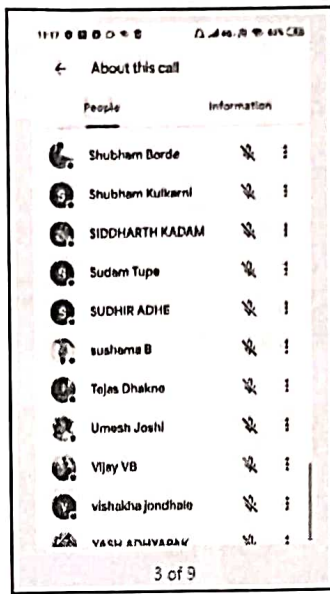
- Selection of potential market
