Introduction

Education, being the principal tool for the development of human resources, has a direct contribution towards achievement of economic goals and aspiration of the country. In order to assure progress in attaining the goals described in this Agreement, it is agreed that the Director of MIT, Aurangabad and Excelize Systems will annually review the scope and progress of the cooperative activity between Excelize and MIT and policies and programmes related to this Memorandum of Understanding.

Termination Terms

This Memorandum of Understanding shall last for an initial period of five years from the effective date. Either the party is free to withdraw at any time with a 2 month notice period.

Prior written notice to the other party of its intention to withdraw is essential for withdrawal, MIT and Excelize Systems will endeavor to address and correct the concerns of the party, who wishes to withdraw. If those efforts are not successful this Memorandum of Understanding will stand terminated.

Limitations / Boundaries and Future Possibilities

- 1. The association is currently a non-profit making organization, not funded by Excelize to do any research work, and is strictly aimed to provide better industry awareness to MIT students and creating an assured source of manpower for Excelize. Though funding for research work is not in scope right now, it is highly possible that Excelize would like to go for that option very soon.
