## Topic "Quality Assurance Measures"

Prof. (Dr) N.N. Bandela is the Director, IQAC, Dr. Babasaheb Ambadkar Marathwada University. Sir shared a detailed session on benefits of Institutional accreditation like: AISHE, NIRF, RUSA, AICTE etc. He emphasized on topics like: Whether the institution is meeting standards of education, Improving enrichment rate by winning trust of parents and students, Helping employees and enable graduates to attain goal of employability and in turn improve education in the institution.

Sir focused on the seven pillars of quality education which included the 7 criteria of NAAC. Day 1: Session 2

Topic: "Documentation of NAAC Assessment as per new Framework considering Assessment & Accreditation"

Dr Vishnu Patil is Director IQAC, Deogiri College, Aurangabad. He focused on the importance of documentation to get good score and improve NAAC grades. He emphasized on avoiding mistakes in SSR and DVV sheet. How score can be increased by encouraging student participation and certifications.

A detailed criteria wise description of how points can be achieved for different sub points in each criterion was explained. He suggested planning of documentation should be done at the commencement of every academic year is very important. He said team work, passionate staff and motivated faculties for quality initiative is the core of success; It is continuous process.

He gave examples of many institutions about advantages of proper documentation.

Topic: "Between the lines, Peer team management"

Dr. Gulab Khedkar is the director, Paul Hebert Centre for DNA Barcoding and Biodiversity Studies which oversees DNA barcoding involvements in India. Sir mentioned that the people working in any organization play a crucial role in the process of accreditation of that institute.

Different bodies lie AISHE, NIRF, NAAC, AICTE, RUSA, UGC are collecting your data parallelly. The data put up by the institute on the above mentioned platforms should match without any in discrepancies, otherwise it will be identified and notified to the institution.

Some other topics discussed were about the preparedness for the Peer team visit. How to handle situation during the peer team visit. The role of conducting mock NAAC visits, and their reports.



Day 2: Session 4


Resource Person: Dr. Sunil Tekale




Day2: Session 5

Resource Person: Dr. Prashant Ambad


Topic: Course Outcome & Programme Outcome Attainment

कार्यशाळेचे उद्घाटन दीप प्रज्वलनाने मान्यवरांच्या हस्ते करण्यात आले.पुढे बोलतांना प्रमुख वक्ते मानसिंग पवार म्हणाले स्वातंत्र्यपूर्व काळापासूनच्या भारतीय अर्थव्यवस्था व व्यवहार यांचा आढावा घेऊन सध्याच्या काळामध्ये नव उद्योजक बनण्यासाठी स्वतःमध्ये प्रामाणिकपणा असणे, आवड असणे व आत्मविश्वास असणे अत्यावश्यक आहे .तसेच त्यांनी १९९० सालानंतर भारतीय उद्योजकता खऱ्या अर्थाने कशी वाढली यावर आपले विचार मांडले .मुंबईचे डब्बेवाले यांचे उदाहरण देऊन गेल्या १३३ वर्षापासून ते शिकलेले नसताना ही कशे उत्कृष्ट उद्योजक आहेत यांची माहिती त्यांनी
